What information do we store and why?

Our Stats (Similar to the majority of websites online, when someone visits our website we collect internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We collect this information in a way which does not identify you. We will not associate any data gathered from this site with any personally identifiable information from any other source.)
