



Ready 2 Go Curriculum Overview

Ready to Go is taught across school to help prepare students for independent travel and travel training, taught using elements of the Ready to Go (TITAN) road safety scheme. Some elements of the scheme have been adapted or removed as they are taught in other curriculum strands. Ready to Go is taught within other lessons to help embed the learning across a variety of learning contexts and opportunities. The intent of the learning is to develop travel and safety awareness whilst also supporting pupils to understand how this can be achieved out in the community. The scheme of work is taught through different modules and using a tiered red, amber, green system which rewards the students as they progress through the programme with journey badges to recognise their understanding. We have also added a white journey badge which is specific to FNS and recognises that not all of our pupils will be able to access the schemes of work provided by the Titan scheme but that their progress should still be recognised. The white journey badge will mainly apply to Key Stage 2 and 3 pupils on the orange pathway, with pupils progressing as they move through the Key Stages. If pupils are able to progress through all of the badges they can then be referred to the TITAN team and a travel trainer will be assigned to support them to independently travel to their post-16 education placement.
